Springtime

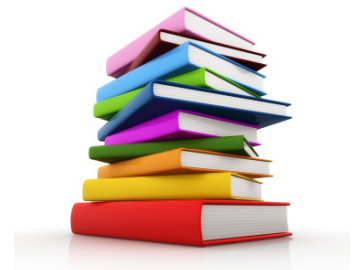
A small green frog

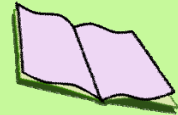
Summer Reading Program Kick off Day:

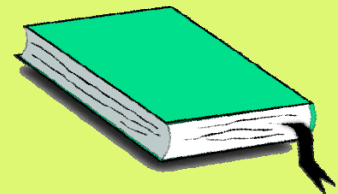
Looking for your favorite new movies?
