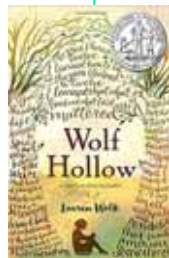

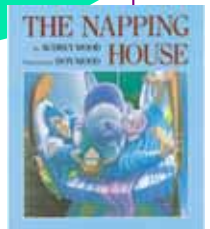

If you need a specific book or genre for class, the Teen Librarian would be happy to help you find the book you need or order it in. Stop by the Information Desk for assistance.

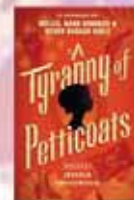

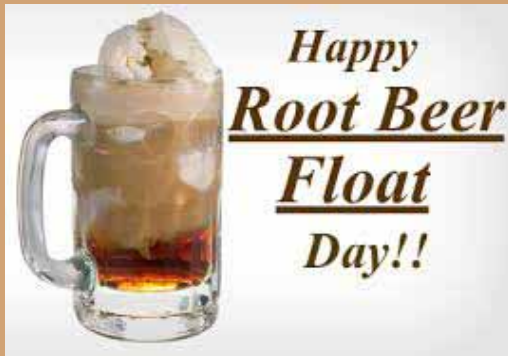
