





For the past 85 years your Canal Fulton Public Library has been proud to serve the educational, social and entrainment needs of this community. First opened in 1939 and housed within a room at the old Canal Fulton High School, it took only a few years to out grow that space whereupon it was moved to a larger room. Demand for library resources and services continued to outgrew this new room as well and before long it was realized that nothing short of its own separate building would do. With extraordinarily generous donations made by Mary and George Muhlhauser, the old home of Timothy Sullivan was purchased and transformed into the new Canal Fulton Public Library. Having officially opened our doors on July 17, 1949, librarians and staff have seen generations of patrons (both old and young) come here to find laughter, learning, life skills and lots more. This building, enjoying our 75th anniversary this month, has itself seen four expansions and with your continued support we can look forward to providing for the needs of many more generations to come!


